Global Medical Technologies de Mexico S.A. de C.V., was established as a subsidiary of Global Medical Technologies in order for the Company to legally hold title to property and assets in Mexico.

Company president, David Hadley, is currently preparing a quotation for the medical equipment needs for the new hospital being built in Cancun, Mexico, by the Loya family. This contract may prove to be a sizable sale for the Company, with estimated sales near \$1,000,000.

The Company is also negotiating a deal for part ownership in the Amerimed Hospital, located in Cancun, Mexico. Company assets are expected to be traded for ownership once all parties are in agreement and documents have been signed. It is very likely that the Company will soon own part of a hospital in Cancun as a result of the hospital owners not having paid for some equipment that was delivered in 2002.

There also exists a tremendous opportunity for GMT de Mexico to take advantage of its relationships with medical specialists in Mexico. There exists opportunities for these specialists to obtain grants from the European Economic Development Commission for projects in biotechnology research. This could prove to be very lucrative considering Limina Biotechnologies, Inc will be doing a considerable amount of research looking for the vaccine to Cryptovirus, and our relationships include Neurosurgeons and Bio-Chemists who are eager to be part of our project team. We believe it will be much easier to produce the vaccine and do research in Mexico where there is far less red tape.

GMT de Mexico also owns Patent rights to medical technology that may be used to prevent blindness in newborn babies who are over exposed to oxygen. It has been found that when a newborn's oxygen saturation levels are too high, the child's risk of experiencing a detached retina is increased. We intend to further develop the technology we have Patent rights to by using engineers and the medical facilities we control in Mexico. There are also several other products planned for development.
